

## EPT handling of empties

All **EPT trays** are part of the **EPT pooling system** and **can be exchanged 1:1 full with empty** along the supply chain.

### EPT handling of empties

- **Separate different sizes of EPT trays** on different CC Containers or shelves and clearly mark each individual stocks.
- **Secure full containers** at least once with foil at the top end if no shelves are used for stabilisation.
- No additional load securing is necessary **when transporting empties on CC containers with shelves**
- **Stickers and labels must be removed as far as possible** before delivery to an EPT depot.
- Stacked **upside down to prevent rainwater** from collecting in the pallets.

**Secure full containers** at least once **with foil**
