Just three years after its foundation, Euro Plant Tray has put four models of the new EPT reusable solution into production. In addition to the two models in the 400 series production of two models in the 200 series started in summer 2025:

EPT 769 for pots measuring 9-10.5 cm and EPT 768 for pots measuring 10.5-13 cm. The two formats are produced by Polytec in Ebensee, Austria. With this third producer, EPT is independently positioned on the market and ensures consistent delivery of all models.

Work is currently underway on the development of EPT 779 to complete the range for the largest user group. EPT 779 in the 400 format transports 9-10.5 cm pots safely from production to wholesalers and marketing organisations to retailers.

The EPT reusable solution guarantees at least 100 tray cycles and is equipped with RFID, 2D data matrix and barcode. This makes the EPT product family unique in the market and future-proof. All common technologies can be used for easy RTI management.
